CN LINES magazine is published approximately every five months with a great variety of stories, both historical and contemporary. Your dues cover four issues and are not based on a calendar year. You will receive as many issues as you paid for, even if four issues takes two years.

Topics included are steam and diesel locomotives, freight and passenger cars, railway structures, drawings and charts, operational information, railway history and reminiscences. Also included are product and service announcements, new books, and from time-to-time a question and answer page, modelling tips and examples.

Recent issues have been 44 or 48 pages (there is no advertising), with colour pictures, a professional layout and coated paper for better quality reproduction.

In addition to CN LINES magazine, we have produced a large variety of accurate decals, and HO brass steam engine cab numerals and steam locomotive number plates. These are available from the Treasurer (address in magazine, p.2). We import 18 colours of Scalecoat I paint which cannot be exported because of flammability.
